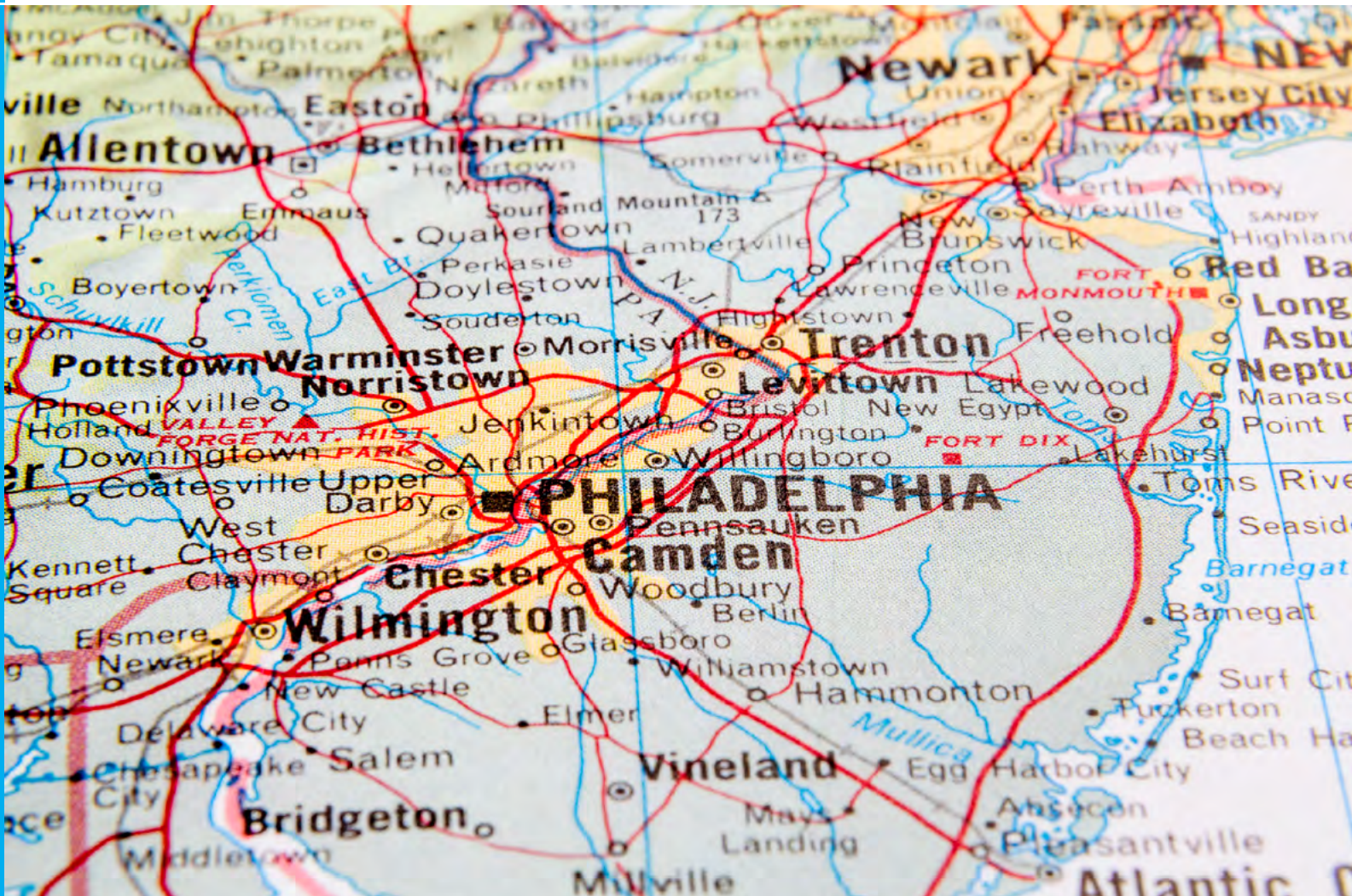

PC Tour / PTU Tour Requirements:

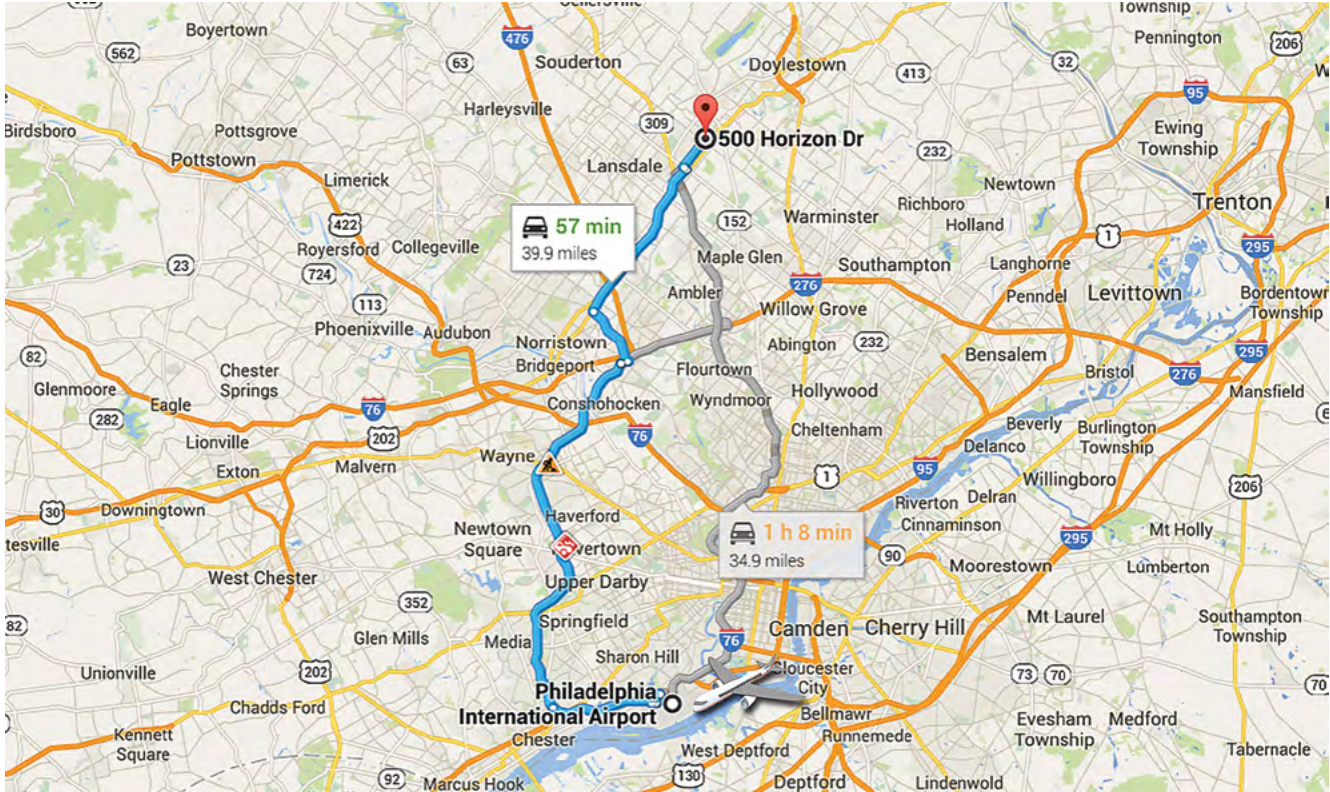
No open-toe shoes are allowed within the manufacturing areas of the Product Centers

- Dresses or skirts should not be worn

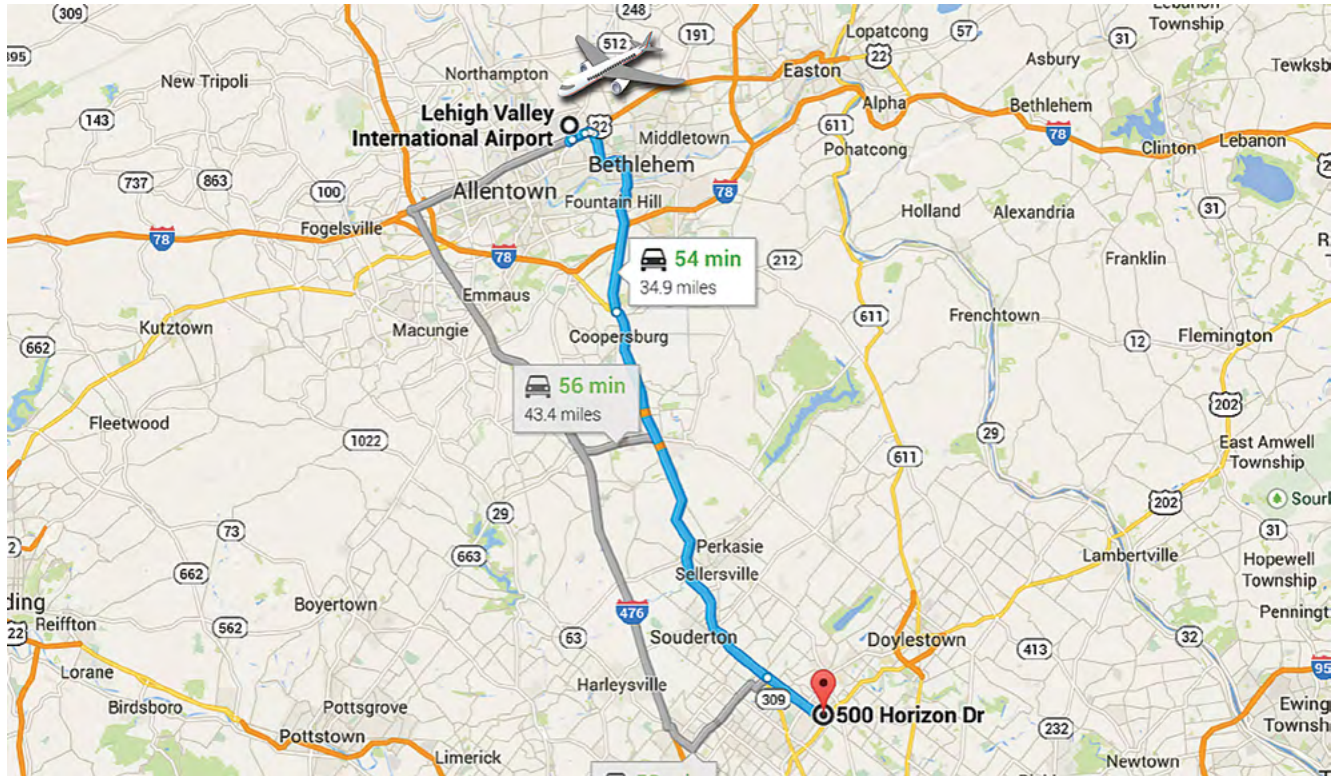


Directions from Philadelphia International Airport to North East Regional Center (NERC)



1. Head east on Industrial Hwy43 ft
2. Slight right toward International Plaza Dr469 ft
3. Take the 1st left onto International Plaza Dr174 ft
4. Take the 1st left0.3 mi
5. Take the 1st right onto Bartram Ave0.6 mi
6. Sharp right to merge onto I-95 S0.6 mi
7. Merge onto I-95 S4.4 mi
8. Take exit 7 for I-476 N0.6 mi
9. Continue onto I-476 N19.4 mi
10. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Exit 2056 ft
11. Take exit 20 for Germantown Pike W0.5 mi
12. Merge onto W Germantown Pike2.9 mi
13. Turn right onto US-202 N/Dekalb Pike and Continue to follow US-202 N8.2 mi
14. Turn left onto PA-463 W0.2 mi
15. Take the 1st right onto Upper State Rd1.8 mi
16. Turn left onto Highpoint Dr459 ft
17. Take the 1st left onto Horizon Dr (**Destination will be on the left**)459 ft

Directions from Lehigh Valley International Airport to North East Regional Center (NERC)



1. Head west43 ft
2. Slight right toward City Line Rd 0.6 mi
3. Slight right onto City Line Rd144 ft
4. Sharp right onto PA-987 S 0.7 mi
5. Merge onto US-22 E via the ramp to Bethlehem 0.4 mi
6. Merge onto US-22 E..... 0.7 mi
7. Take the PA-378 S exit toward Bethlehem/Schoenersville Rd..... 0.2 mi
8. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Bethlehem/PA-378 S..... 0.2 mi
9. Continue onto PA-378 S 9.5 mi
10. Turn left onto PA-309 S.....19.4 mi
11. Turn left onto Line Lexington Rd269 ft
12. Turn right onto County Line Rd..... 2.8 mi
13. Turn left onto Horizon Dr (**Destination will be on the right**) 0.4 mi

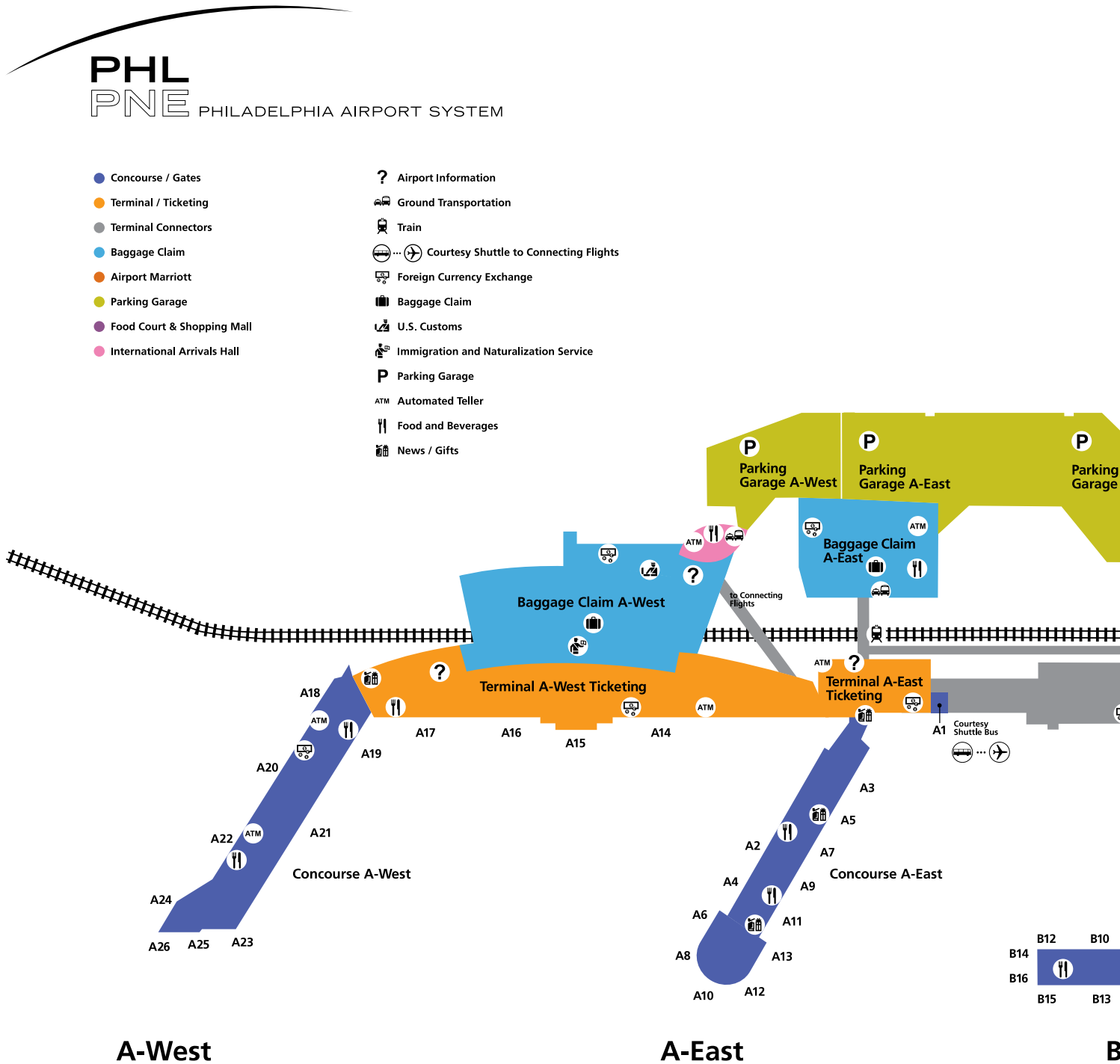

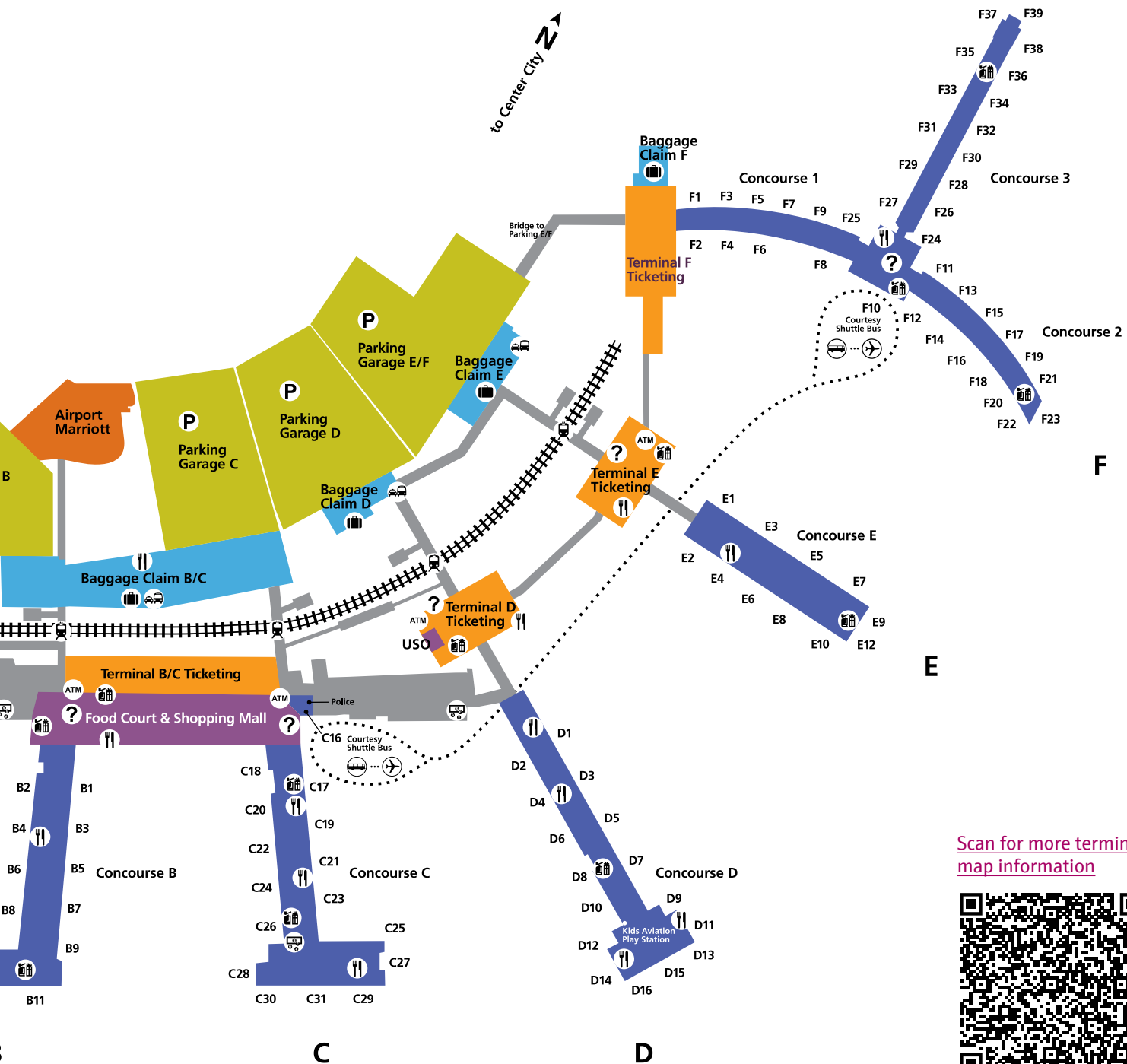

Taxi Services:

Taxicabs are available at both airports upon your arrival. At Philadelphia International Airport, taxis can be accessed at Zone 5. At Lehigh Valley International Airport, taxis are available outside baggage claim.

Uber/Lyft

App-based ride-share services, such as Uber and Lyft, are available at the Philadelphia and Lehigh Valley International airports. At Philadelphia International Airport, riders can access the ride-share pick-up location outside baggage claim. At Lehigh Valley International Airport, Uber and Lyft are available for pick up on the 2nd level of the Main Terminal.

Local Attractions

Philadelphia plays home to an astounding collection of museums, artistic venues and historical attractions. There's the Liberty Bell, of course – plus amazing art installations, jazz venues, architectural landmarks and much more.

Philadelphia Museum of Art The Philadelphia Museum of Art was forever immortalized in the classic Rocky film franchise. While the “Rocky Steps” draw a slew of visitors who want to reenact Stallone’s on-screen training regimen, the museum is even more impressive inside. The astounding art collection here comprises more than 200 galleries housing more than 227,000 works in media, including photography, sculpture, paintings, textiles and more.

The Rocky Statue and the Rocky Steps The Rocky Statue and the Rocky Steps are two of the most popular attractions in Philadelphia. We don’t have an exact visitor count, but if we did it would be near the top. The Art Museum steps have been declared the second most famous movie location in the entire world(!). Visiting the statue, running up the steps, and taking a picture at the top is pretty much a must on your first visit to Philly. It’s a right of passage.

Reading Terminal Market The number one most visited attraction in Philadelphia is Reading Terminal Market, the city’s famous indoor foodie paradise that is a one-stop shop for everything from local produce and delicious sandwiches to artisanal cheeses and desserts. More than six million people(!) a year visit the market and for good reason: it’s amazing.

Independence National Historical Park Known as the birthplace of American democracy, Historic Philadelphia’s Independence National Historical Park (INHP) is located on the site of many of the seminal events that carried the nation through its founding as a global leader of democratic ideals. INHP welcomes more than 3.5 million visitors every year.

The Liberty Bell Center The majority of the 3.5 million visitors to Independence National Historical Park every year line up to see what is the park’s most visited and most famous attraction, the Liberty Bell.

Independence Hall While historical attractions abound in Philly, Independence Hall has particular significance to the development of the nation. In this building in 1776, the Founding Fathers came together to sign the Declaration of Independence. Eleven years later, representatives from a dozen states met here to lay the framework for the U.S. Constitution. Today, the building is the centerpiece of Independence National Historical Park, and guided tours are available to visitors year-round.

The Philadelphia Zoo Situated on 42 acres of lush gardens, the Philadelphia Zoo is home to nearly 1,300 animals – many rare and endangered. In addition to leading the way in conservation efforts, America’s first zoo features award-winning exhibits such as First Niagara Big Cat Falls, the McNeil Avian Center, the PECO Primate Reserve and seasonal family-friendly events. The zoo welcomes more than a million visitors every year.

It’s also home to the Tuttleman IMAX Theater and the renowned Fels Planetarium.

The bell now called the **Liberty Bell** was cast in the Whitechapel Foundry in the East End of London and sent to the building currently known as Independence Hall, then the Pennsylvania State House, in 1753.
